Residential Dual Diagnosis Substance Use Disorder Services Admission Process



Families interested in having youth admitted to the program can expect the following process:

- Schedule an assessment appointment
- Pre-assessment drug screen (if medically supervised detox is necessary we will refer out for this service)
- Bio-psycho-social assessment. Families should be prepared with:
 - History of MH issues and Diagnosis
 - History of Substance Use issues
 - History of Mental Health and Substance Use Treatment
 - Medications past and present
 - Family history
 - Other relevant information
- Assessing clinician will present information to insurance company for authorization to admit
- Harmony Hill admission paperwork will be completed after authorization to admit is received
- If authorized, youth will be admitted immediately and will need the following items:
 - Current medications in original bottles
 - 5-7-day supply of clothing
 - No more than 2 pairs of shoes
 - Cell phones/electronic devices and jewelry are not permitted
 - Hygiene products are provided by HHS
